The Question of God's Love

John 3:16

Introduction: There is a huge difference between Calvinism's view of God, sin, and salvation and that which is presented as the biblical teaching. The difference is "Calvinism's love," which isn't love at all.

After we get through the mountains of rationale and oceans of speculative theories the one thing that is blaringly obvious is that the God of Calvinism and the God of Scripture look very different.
