The Gifts of the Holy Spirit

1 Corinthians 12:1-4

Introduction: The questions surrounding the gifts of the Spirit are a source of constant debate. As with other issues that we have seen with the Spirit too often there is more reliance given on feelings than the Word of God.

The doctrine of spiritual gifts is almost exclusively a Pauline doctrine, the only use of the word outside of Paul being in 1 Peter 4:10. The major passage in Ephesians 4 attributes the giving of gifts to the risen and ascended Christ. The major passage in 1 Corinthians 12 emphasizes the Spirit's work as the One who gives gifts. The other principal passage is Romans 12.
